Learn how to find your family's roots at this free program sponsored by the Jewish Genealogical Society of Greater Boston (JGSGB). Society members Fay Bussgang, former co-president, and Carol Clingan, vice president, will describe the many records available locally and in Eastern Europe and how to access them, as well as the myriad of materials now available on the Internet. They will show what gems of information they have discovered from these sources.

Bussgang of Lexington received a Bachelor of Arts in psychology from Wellesley College and a Doctor of Education from Harvard University. She and her Polish-born husband, Julian, have made 11 trips to Poland to do extensive genealogical research. They translated into English two volumes of war-time accounts of child survivors who still live in Poland, *The Last Eyewitnesses: Children of the Holocaust Speak*. Bussgang has written numerous papers on Jewish genealogy.

Clingan of Newton received a Bachelor of Arts from Wellesley College and a Master of Arts from Columbia University, majoring in Modern European History. She retired two years ago as Director of Strategic Communications at Fleet Bank, after working in publishing and corporate communications for 40 years. She now does genealogical research and volunteers as vice president at Temple Beth Elohim and president of Action for Post-Soviet Jewry.
