The British Broadcasting Corporation produced a series of films that followed popular figures as they traced their roots. The subject of this particular episode is Stephen Fry, the English comedian, writer, actor, humorist, novelist, columnist, filmmaker, and television personality—famous in America for his role in the TV series *Jeeves and Wooster*.

This BBC film realistically portrays the joys and sorrows of a genealogical search, from an initial spark of interest through the process of interviewing family, going to archives, traveling to ancestral lands, visiting important people and places of the past, hiring a researcher, and using sites on the Internet.

Following the showing of the film, a panel of experienced researchers from our Society will discuss how they have gone about conducting their own research and will answer questions.
